

Thank you for your interest in the Saddle Up for St. Jude-Hungerford fundraiser. St. Jude is the only pediatric cancer research center where families never pay for treatments that are not covered by insurance. No child is ever denied treatment because of the family's inability to pay. The hospital's daily operating costs are \$1.5 million, which are primarily covered by public contributions. The survival rate for acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL), the most common form of childhood cancer, was 4% in 1962. Thanks to research and treatment protocols developed at St. Jude the survival rate for this once deadly disease is now 94% .

There will be a 5 mile and a 10 mile marked trail for the Saddle Up for St. Jude's event.

To make your day more enjoyable please be aware of the following: Seating is limited - for your comfort please bring a folding chair. Live Acoustic music Saturday evening - weather permitting. Horses will not be permitted to be tied to trees at any time. Parking is limited so all participants will be directed to a parking space by event volunteers upon arrival. Non-riding guests are welcome to come and show their support for St. Jude's and to participate in the silent auction. A free will offering jar will be available for non-participant guest who would like to eat lunch at the event. Any child riding with someone participating in the St. Jude's event must have a release form signed by the parent or guardian prior to mounting a horse, even if they are not fundraising.

Every participant must sign a hard copy of the release form the day of the event - (participants under 18 years of age MUST have a parent or guardian sign the Consent Form). ALL Riders will need to sign the release form, turn in their pledge donations and receive a wrist band BEFORE beginning the ride. For minors attending the event without their parent or guardian you will have to request a HARD COPY release form prior to the event and have it signed by your parent or legal guardian.
